### **Beginning Pottery**

This class is for students wanting to gain greater confidence with handbuilding and design techniques or to have the time to concentrate further on more complex functional forms.

## **Winter Wood Fire**

*Prior experience with ceramics highly recommended*

**Thursday evenings: January 12-March 16, 6-9pm**

**Instructor: Chris Drobnock, Wood Fire Artist in Residence**

**\$290 members/\$305 non-members**

**(tuition: \$210 for members/ \$225 for non-members**

**PLUS \$80 firing/fuel fee)**

Students will explore new ideas and possibilities for wheel thrown forms and sculptures that will be fired in the wood kiln. Demonstrations and lectures on wood firing techniques will be given each class, allowing students plenty of time to concentrate on their own ideas. Students will be expected to spend some weekend time at the wood kiln helping to prepare for firings by splitting and stacking wood and assisting with overall kiln maintenance.
